

# ANOTHER WAY: ELIGIBILITY

Another Way is a programme funded by the Youth Endowment Fund and the Home Office intended to reduce youth violence and establish the effectiveness of an approach known as focused deterrence. It is being delivered by a partnership between Nottingham City Council, Notts Police and the Violence Reduction Partnership supported by other partners

## To be included a young person must:

1 - be between 14 and 24 years old.

2 - live in Nottingham City or have a connection through friends or family.

3 - have been arrested for at least one of the following offences in the last year.

- Violence against the person
- Robbery
- Possession of weapons offences

4 - AND arrested for at least one of the following offences as part of a group of 3 or more over the last 2 years.

- Violence against the person
- Robbery
- Possession of weapons offences
- Criminal damage and arson
- Drug offences
- Public disorder

If they do not meet **criteria '3'** but meet all other criteria then the following will be considered on a case-by-case basis

- Other offences committed in the last 12 months including drug offences, criminal damage and arson, and public disorder offences
- Intelligence review that indicates that they are part of an offending group
- Evidence of county lines involvement or criminal exploitation
- Family links to violent offenders
- Out of Force offending
